Chairman Beauregard informed his fellow board members that Mr. Tomasia had been the manager previously from 2008 through 2010, and that he's been an active officer and member of the 'club' for many years; and that there were no problems during that time.

When asked by Commissioner Almeida if he was T.I.P.S. Certified, Mr. Tomasia stated that he had been in the past but would go to get re-certified, as well as ensure that all the bartenders were certified as well.

Voted: Commissioner Almeida made a motion to approve the petition as presented, and to forward the application to the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission for their approval; with the stipulation that Mr. Tomasia submit a copy of his T.I.P.S. Certification to the Licensing Board office within thirty (30) days of receiving final approval or prior. – **Unanimous**

Responding to questions from Chairman Beauregard, Mr. Gibau stated that he's been a member of the 'club' for five years and that he's served as auditor, which included the duties of ordering the alcohol and has been the Treasurer for the past two years.

Responding further, Mr. Gibau stated that he also works there as a bartender and that he's there almost every day, and that he's at the club at least 30-40 hours a week; and if there's a party in the hall, he's on call, if needed.

Responding to further questions from Chairman Beauregard, Mr. Gibau stated that he was familiar with the Rules and Regulations, and that he was aware that 'under 21' events weren't allowed, and that they only book the hall for 21+ events, and that minors are only allowed in the hall during family type events.

When asked by Commissioner Almeida if he was T.I.P.S. Certified, Mr. Gibau stated that he was, and that all the bartenders were as well.

Voted: Commissioner Almeida made a motion to approve the petition as presented, and to forward the application to the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission for their approval; with the stipulation that Mr. Gibau submit a copy of his T.I.P.S. Certification to the Licensing Board office within thirty (30) days of receiving final approval or prior. – **Unanimous**

Responding to questions from Chairman Beauregard, Mr. Ferreira stated that he's been a member for five years and that he's served as secretary until he was voted in as the bar manager; and that he's at the 'club' about three hours a day, sometimes in the morning and sometimes at night.

Chairman Beauregard informed Mr. Ferreira that the Board has received a lot of complaints from the neighbors regarding the 'club', to which Mr. Ferreira responded, we try our best, and added, now that I'm the manager, I'll be there more often than the previous manager was, which I hope will help.

When asked by Chairman Beauregard as to how many members they had, Mr. Ferreira stated that they had about 100 members, and that the membership fee was \$30.00 a year.

Chairman Beauregard informed Mr. Ferreira that a lot of the complaints that the Board has received are with regard to over serving resulting in people coming out of the 'club' intoxicated, who then are causing a disturbance in the neighborhood; about which Chairman Beauregard stated, it's now your responsibility to ensure that this doesn't continue. Mr. Ferreira stated that he's instructed his bartenders not to serve anyone that comes in intoxicated, as well as not to serve anyone to intoxication; and added that he understood that it's now his job.

Mr. Ferreira stated that the Vice-President (Denis Paim) also assists in overseeing the bar when he's not there.

When asked by Chairman Beauregard as to what time they close at night, Mr. Ferreira stated they close around 11:00 p.m. or 11:30 p.m. ... 12 o'clock the latest ... depending on how many people are in the 'club'.

Capt. Vicente questioned Mr. Ferreira regarding a recent hall rental, which is located on the 2nd Floor, of which he became aware of that had the potential to become a dangerous situation due to the fact that it was a fundraiser for a known 'gang member', and that it was being put on by a bunch of teenagers. Capt. Vicente informed the Board that he sent one of his detectives to the club and that they were very co-operative, and they canceled the event; but he questioned why the event was booked in the first place, and asked who would be responsible for booking the hall.

Capt. Vicente informed Mr. Ferreira that as manager, it's now his responsibility to know who he's renting the second floor hall to and what they're renting it for, to which Mr. Ferreira stated that he understood.

In response to Capt. Vicente's comments, Chairman Beauregard asked Mr. Nanopoulos to get some "Hall Rental" agreements from the office, which were then presented to Mr. Ferreira with instructions that any time the hall is rented out, an agreement should be filled out and kept on file, so that the Police or the Board will know to whom the hall was rented to and for what purpose.

Mr. Nanopoulos informed the Board that he believed that the 2nd floor hall was not on the licensed premises and that alcohol shouldn't be served or consumed in that area, which was later confirmed upon looking at the office copy of the license.

Chairman Beauregard instructed Mr. Ferreira that alcohol cannot be served or consumed in that area until such a time as that area is added to the description of the license, which would require an application to be filed with the Licensing Board and approved by the ABCC; to which Mr. Ferreira stated that he understood, and was later told that he would be contacted by Mr. Nanopoulos to start that process.

Chairman Beauregard instructed Mr. Ferreira that he was not to rent out that hall until it's been added to the license, to which Mr. Ferreira responded, I understand.

When asked by Commissioner Craig if he had another job besides being the manager of the club, Mr. Ferreira stated that he has a part-time job about 4 hours a day.

Chairman Beauregard informed Mr. Ferreira that the police and the Board would be monitoring the 'club' closely over the next few months.

Voted: Commissioner Almeida made a motion to approve the petition as presented, and to forward the application to the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission for their approval; with the stipulation that Mr. Ferreira submit a copy of his T.I.P.S. Certification to the Licensing Board office within thirty (30) days of receiving final approval or prior. –
